## Congress venue

The conference will take place at the University of Lausanne, which is close to the city center. The city of Lausanne is the fourth largest city of Switzerland, it is ideally situated next to Lake Geneva and the Alps, beside the wine region of Lavaux, which is a UNESCO world heritage.

Lausanne, the Olympic capital, offers a unique combination of naturalistic and cultural amenities that will provide a pleasant and relaxed atmosphere for networking with leading experts, emerging scholars, and enthusiastic young students in personality psychology.

Lausanne is located 60 km from the international airport of Geneva, and fast and frequent connections link Geneva airport to the center of Lausanne. Every hour trains arrive from all four corners of Switzerland and Europe, stopping in the center of the city. You can also fly to the international airport of Zurich.

A train station is also located near the airport. Connection time between Zurich and Lausanne is approximately 2 hours.

The EAPP currently has over 200 active members from countries all over the world.
