

## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

### 2018 EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award

The EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award was established in 2014. Its purpose is to promote personality psychology in Europe and to increase the visibility of outstanding personality psychologists both to the scientific community and to the general public. The Award honours personality psychologists with a mature, influential record of research. From 2018 onwards, the Award will be given every two years.

The 2018 EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award will be presented at the 19th European Conference on Personality that will take place on 17-21 July 2018 in Zadar, Croatia. The winner of the Award receives a plaque, a personal prize of 1,000 EUR, and a one year free membership to the EAPP. The winner will be announced prior to the ECP19 in Zadar and will be invited to give a keynote-type presentation at the conference.

#### ***Eligibility Criteria***

To be eligible for the Award, candidates must be active members of EAPP. They must be actively involved in research at the time of their nomination and they should have obtained their PhD degree **between 12 and 25 years ago at the month of reception of the award**. The winner of the Award is expected to attend the ECP19; the registration fee as well as the costs for traveling and accommodation will be sponsored by EAPP. No present member of the EAPP Executive Committee can be nominated for the Award.

#### ***Nomination Procedure***

Nominations for the Award may be submitted by any EAPP member and must be supported by at least one additional EAPP member. The submissions should provide:

1. A supporting statement (no more than 700 words) setting out the nominee's achievements which are considered to merit the award;
2. Curriculum vitae of the nominee (no more than 3500 words or 10 pages PDF).

The Award committee may request further information from the proposer of a nomination.

#### ***Award Committee***

An Award Committee appointed by the EAPP Executive Committee will review all nominations for the EAPP Mid-Career Award and will decide on a winner. The Award Committee will consist of four members (including a Chair): Prof. Rainer Riemann as previous winner of the Award; Prof. Denis Bratko as a researcher from the ECP19 hosting country; and Prof. Simine Vazire as a further member of the EAPP. The Award Committee will be chaired by Prof. Anu Realo (member of the EAPP Executive Committee).

#### ***Deadline for Nominations***
