

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

2018 EAPP European Personality Psychology Life-Time Achievement Award

The EAPP European Personality Psychology Life-Time Achievement Award was established in 2012. Its purpose is to promote personality psychology in Europe and to increase the visibility of outstanding personality psychologists both to the scientific community as well as to the general public. The award honors outstanding researchers whose life work has had a significant and profound impact on the field of personality psychology. From 2018 onwards, the Award will be given every two years.

The 2018 EAPP European Personality Psychology Life-Time Achievement Award will be presented at the 19th European Conference on Personality that will take place on 17-21 July 2018 in Zadar, Croatia. The winner of the Award receives a plaque, a personal prize of 1,000 EUR, and a one year free membership to the EAPP. The winner will be announced prior to the ECP19 in Zadar and will be invited to give a keynote-type presentation at the conference.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Award, candidates must be active members of EAPP. The winner of the Award is expected to attend the ECP19; the registration fee as well as the costs for traveling and accommodation will be sponsored by EAPP. No present member of the EAPP Executive Committee can be nominated for the Award.

Nomination procedure

Nominations for the Award may be submitted by any EAPP member and must be supported by at least one additional EAPP member. The submissions should provide:

1. A supporting statement (no more than 700 words) setting out the nominee's achievements which are considered to merit the award;
2. Curriculum vitae of the nominee (no more than 3500 words or 10 pages PDF).

The Award committee may request further information from the proposer of a nomination.

Award Committee

An Award Committee appointed by the EAPP Executive Committee will review all nominations for the EAPP Life-Time Achievement Award and will decide on a winner. The Award Committee will consist of three highly reputable EAPP members. This time, Prof. Manfred Schmitt (EC member) will chair the Award Committee. In addition, Prof. Jens Asendorpf as previous winner of the award and Prof. Wendy Johnson as an additional EAPP member agreed to be members of this committee.

Deadline for Nominations

Nomination deadline is 15 March 2018 at 12 midnight CET. Nominations should be sent to the Chair of the Awards Committee by email at schmittm@uni-landau.de.
