2020 EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award

The EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award was established in 2014. Its purpose is to promote personality psychology in Europe and to increase the visibility of outstanding personality psychologists both to the scientific community and to the general public. The Award honors personality psychologists with a mature, influential record of research in the study of personality individual differences and processes (broadly defined). From 2018 onwards, the award will be given every two years.

The 2020 EAPP European Personality Psychology Mid-Career Award will be presented at the 20th European Conference on Personality (ECP20) that will take place on 14-17 July 2020 in Madrid, Spain. The winner of the award receives a plaque, a personal prize of 1,000 EUR, a one year free membership to the EAPP, and up to 500 Euros in travel reimbursement to attend the 2020 ECP conference in Madrid. The winner will be announced prior to the ECP20 and will be invited to give a keynote-type presentation at the conference.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the award, candidates must be active members of EAPP and have a visible contribution to personality psychology in the Europe. They must be actively involved in research at the time of their nomination and they should have obtained their PhD degree between 12 and 25 years ago at the month of reception of the award. The winner of the award is expected to attend the ECP20. No present member of the EAPP Executive Committee can be nominated for the award.

Nomination Procedure

Nominations for the award may be submitted by any EAPP member and must be supported by at least one additional EAPP member. The submissions should provide: 1. A supporting statement (no more than 750 words) setting out the nominee's achievements which are considered to merit the award; and 2. CV of the nominee (no more than 3500 words or 10 pages PDF). The Award Committee may request further information from the proposer of a nomination.

An Award Committee appointed by the EAPP Executive Committee will review all nominations for the EAPP Mid-Career Award and will decide on a winner. The Award Committee will consist of 3 members (including a Chair). Nomination deadline is **March 31th 2020** at 12 midnight CET.
